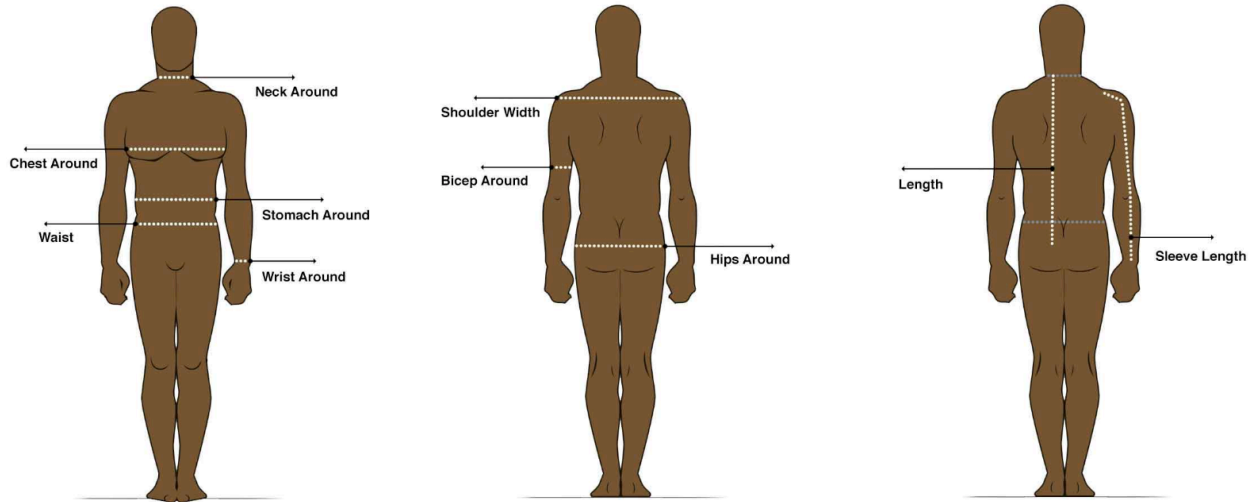


# Agbada Outfit Measurements



## Helpful Tips

- Wear light clothing that doesn't add too much bulk (a t-shirt and some lightweight pants for example).
- Remove any items from your pockets and remove your belt.
- For the most accurate results, visit a local tailor or have a friend take the measurements for you.
- When having your measurements taken, try to stand as relaxed and comfortable as possible - as you normally would.
- Measure twice! If you don't get the same measurement both times try again.
- All measurements should be taken to the nearest quarter 1/4 inch.

## Measurements

<b>Neck Around</b> Measure around the neck at the height where the collar would normally rest.	
<b>Shoulder Width</b> Measure from one shoulder edge to the other. Be sure to follow the curve of the shoulder when measuring.	
<b>Sleeve / Bicep Around</b> Measure around your arm, the fullest part of your bicep area.	
<b>Sleeve Length</b> From your shoulder to where you want the sleeve to end.	
<b>Wrist Around</b> Measure around your wrist around the wrist bone. Hold the tape measure tight to your skin, but do not squeeze your wrist.	
<b>Top Length</b> Start at the center of the shoulder and measure straight down to the point till where you want your top.	
<b>Chest Around</b> Measure around the fullest part of your chest.	
<b>Stomach Around</b> Measure around your stomach, where your belly button is.	
<b>Waist Around</b> Measure around your waist, where your belt usually sits.	
<b>Hips Around</b> Measure around the fullest part of your hips and buttocks.
